

On their walk they noticed a little egg all by itself.


Jude and Milla decided that they should look for the egg's parents. Let's ask the other animals if this egg belongs to them.

"Sorry, Jude and Milla, I do lay eggs but this egg is not mine!" replied Myrtle.








Jude and Milla went home and made a nest.
