Measure and cut squares of fabric using the pinking shears in various sizes, for example:

20x20cm 30x30cm, 40x40cm.

Jojoba or coconut oil to the

2. Lay out towel on an ironing board or flat surface and heat the iron.



Place some sheets of baking paper over the towel and then place your fabric squares on top, with the right side facing up.



Place some more baking paper over the top of the beeswax and fabric squares and carefully iron over the top of it.

Peel the baking paper back. Check to ensure the wax has evenly melted. If more coverage is required in any areas, you can sprinkle some more wax on the fabric, re-cover with baking paper and iron again.

4. Sprinkle the grated beeswax over the fabric

You will need to ensure the beeswax is sprinkled evenly over the fabric and right to the edges.
